Thank you for the application for decision in terms of the heritage legislation. The general area of Newcastle is well known for yielding heritage resources of archaeological, historical and paleontological value. The proposed project could impact on informal graves, structures, archaeological and palaeontological resources that are protected in terms of sections 33, 34, 35, and 36 of the KwaZulu-Natal Heritage Act (No. 4 of 2008) as well as sections 34, 35, and 36 of the NHRA during earth-moving activities.

The application has been considered and Amafa requires a heritage impact assessment covering social/public consultation on the possibility of graves and military history as well as a specialist report to be compiled by a paleontologist as the proposed site is underlain by sediments of very high paleontological sensitivity. The paleontologist should compile a protocol for finds to form part of the EMPr.

The Study should cover:

- Identification of all heritage resources in the development area and its surroundings -50m
- Assessment of the impact of the development on such heritage
- Evaluation of the impact of the development on heritage resources relative to the sustainable social and economic benefits to be derived from the development
- Results of consultation with communities affected by the proposed development and other interested and affected parties regarding the impact of the development on heritage resources.
- Consideration of alternatives if heritage resources are affected by the development
- Mitigation plans for any adverse effects during and after completion of the project
- Table of all heritage resources identified .This should show Heritage resource type, description, location, significance and reasons for this rating.
