Dear Dr Brain, Prof. Pickering and Dr Sutton,

the APMHPB permit committee at SAHRA has received your application for excavation at Swartkrans, Member 1, Member 3 and Member 4. The committee and an external reviewer have considered your permit application and agreed in issuing the permit.

Beyond the conditions listed in the report SAHRA requires a separate permit application for infrastructure such as the retaining wall of concrete inter-licking block installed over the face of the excavated material at Member 1 Lower Bank and the wire mesh and metal roof to be installed over the east wall of the Member 3 hole and near the base of the M3 hole.

If the work has already been undertaken, the excavators are requested to apply for a retrospective permit.


