Although the Archaeology database indicates presence of Stone Age sites in this area, none were found or noted in the development footprint. There are however three Burial grounds with a total of 45 graves.. These are well documented in the report. The graves should not be disturbed in any way without a permit from Amafa. No development is allowed within 25m of the Burial Ground documented as Cemetery I - 14 graves, Cemetery II- 18 graves and Cemetery III - 13 graves.

In view of the findings outlined in the HIA Report by Gavin Whitelaw, Frans E Roodt and Frand Roodt of Shasa Heritage Consultants that we received for the above proposed development, we have no objection to the proposed development within limits of the prescribed mitigation measures and recommendations.

You are also required to adhere to the below-mentioned standard conditions:

Conditions:

- 1. Amafa should be contacted if any heritage objects are identified during earthmoving activities and all development should cease until further notice.
- 2. No structures older than sixty years or parts thereof are allowed to be demolished altered or extended without a permit from Amafa.
