Grave Management Report: Recommendations for the management of possible grave sites at the Tshamahansi Borrow Pit Extension, Mogalakwena Municipality area, Limpopo Province. Prepared By: G&A Heritage Prepared For: Tekplan Environmental

G&A Heritage was appointed by Tekplan Environmental Consultants to undertake a Heritage Impact Assessment for the proposed extention of the Tshamahansi Borrow Pit as according the NHRA act of 1999 no.25.As stupilated by the legislation an assessment was conducted the author was able to give a detailed account of the assessment itself. The author of the report was able to suggest two options as guidelines to consider in dealing with the three sites. However, the SAHRA Burial Grounds & Graves Unit would like to recommend scenario1 would be more viable. Due to the fact that scenario 1 has the lowest impact approach and proposes the avoidance of the burial site areas within the borrow pit. However, the BGG unit recommended that the safety buffer should be 30m instead of 10m around the burial area be adhered to. This will ensure that the three burial sites are not damaged during the construction phase of the pit. The graves can remain *insitu* for as long as possible, a Conservation Management Plan should be included as part of the long term conservation and management of the three sites.
