**The KZN Department of Transport (DOT) proposes to upgrade the existing access road to a Type 7A Local Road (gravel road) which is 3.761km in length and 6m in width that conforms to DOT standards. The existing road will be upgraded in one of the Nqutu villages on local road L2718.**

The Basic information provided has been reviewed and following a database analysis, it is noted that the development falls in an area that is generally associated with presence of heritage resources including stone tools and iron age structures.
