The proposed development entails the installation of a larger stormwater pipeline in the Heinrich Avenue region of Karen Park, north of Pretoria, necessitated by rapid urban development in the region.

The author states that no archaeological heritage sites are known or were found to occur in the study area and that any historic farmsteads older than 60 years that may have existed have either disappeared or have been significantly altered.

#### **Final comment**
