### Interim Comment

In terms of palaeontological heritage, the SA Palaeontological Sensitivity Map indicates that the study area has High fossil sensitivity, therefore a palaeontological desktop study is required and based on the outcome of the desktop study, a field assessment is likely. Once this study has been submitted, SAHRA will be able to provide further comments.

In terms of archaeology, the SAHRA Archaeology, Palaeontology and Meteorites Unit has no objections to this proposed development, provided that the recommendations in the specialist reports and this comment are adhered to, and on the following conditions:
