# The proposed upgrade of the Boshof Combined School in the Tokologo Local Municipality, Lejweleputswa District, Free State Province

The proposed development entails upgrading of the Boshof Combined School, located on a 1.3 hectare portion of Erf 91, Kareehof suburb in Boshof Town, in the Boshof Administrative region in the Free State Province.

The site is currently used as a school and it is the intention through the Free State Accelerated School Infrastructure Delivery Initiative to remove the non-permanent structures and replace them with permanent structures and infrastructure.

The proposed upgrade will be located within the parameters of the existing school boundary.

The heritage specialist states that the western section of the site has already been built-up with non-permanent and permanent structures, while the eastern section of the site is currently used for recreational purposes, and due to the footprint on which the development is to take place is already disturbed by past activities, there are no archaeological sites, cultural heritage sites, historic structures, burial grounds or isolated artefacts likely to be present on the affected landscape, due to the disturbed nature of the site and recommend that the project be exempted from any archaeological assessment studies.
