### Modder East Operations new Kleinfontein Gold Mine Return Water Dam

### Van Vollenhoven, A. August 2012. A Report On A Cultural Heritage Impact Assessment for the Proposed Return Water Dam at the New Kleinfontein Goldmine close to Springs, Gauteng Province

The proposed development entails a new return water dam that will be able to hold approximately 76 000 cubic metres of water, at the New Kleinfontein Gold Mine, as well as a new Stockpile and Pump Station. The site is to the east of Boksburg and to the north of Springs, on the Farm Cloverfield 75 IR.

During the survey no sites of cultural heritage significance were located close to the area to be developed. The author notes that the area is extremely disturbed by recent human activities.

#### Decision:

As there is apparently no evidence of any significant archaeological material in this area, the SAHRA Archaeology, Palaeontology and Meteorites Unit has no objection to the development (in terms of the archaeological component of the heritage resources) on condition that, if any new evidence of archaeological sites or artefacts, palaeontological fossils, graves or other heritage resources are found during development, construction or mining, SAHRA or an archaeologist must be alerted immediately.
