

8. GEORGE SHAW-HUIS, UTRECHT

Beskrywing:

Die eiendom met die sogenaamde George Shaw-huis daarop, synde Erf 246, dorp Utrecht, geleë in die dorpsgebied Utrecht, distrik Utrecht, provinsie Natal, en groot seweduusend eenhonderd vyf-en-veertig (7 145) vierkante meter.

9. ANGLIKAANSE KERKIE, VOORTREKSTRAAT, SWELLENDAM

Beskrywing:

Die eiendom met die ou Anglikaanse Kerkgeboujie bekend as St Luke's daarop, synde die Restant van Erf 1034, Swellendam, geleë in die munisipaliteit en administratiewe distrik Swellendam, en groot een-duisend driehonderd (1 300) vierkante meter.

10. ALMARDE-OPSTAL, SONSKYN, DISTRIK WORCESTER

Die historiese Almarde-opstal, bestaande uit al die geboue binne die ringmuur, die ringmuur self en die nabygeleë rietdakhuisie, geleë op 'n gedeelte van sekere stuk afgeskafte erfgrond in die afdeling Worcester, synde die plaas Sonskyn 299.

11. PALINGGAT-OPSTAL EN PALINGFONTEIN-TJIE, PLATTE BOSCH, DISTRIK STILBAAI

Beskrywing:

Die historiese Palinggat-opstal en die nabygeleë palingfonteintjie, elk met 20 meter grond daaromheen, geleë op Gedeelte 57 ('n gedeelte van Gedeelte 56) van die plaas Plate Bosch 485, geleë in die munisipaliteit Stilbaai, afdeling Riversdal.

12. VICTORIAANSE WOONHUIS, LANGLEYWEG, WYNBERG, KAAPSTAD

Beskrywing:

Die eiendom tesame met die Victoriaanse woonhuis daarop, synde die Restant van Erf 67076, Kaapstad te Wynberg, geleë in die stad Kaapstad, Kaapse Afdeling, en groot seshonderd-en-ses (606) vierkante meter.

13. NEDERDUITSE GEREFORMEerde KERKGEBOU EN KERKKLOK, ADENDORP, DISTRIK GRAAFF-REINET

Beskrywing:

8. GEORGE SHAW HOUSE, UTRECHT

Description:

The property with the so-called George Shaw house thereon, being Erf 246, Town of Utrecht, situated in the Township of Utrecht, District of Utrecht, Province of Natal, in extent seven thousand one hundred and forty-five (7 145) square metres.

9. ANGLICAN CHURCH, VOORTREK STREET, SWELLENDAM

Description:

The property with the old Anglican Church building known as St Luke's thereon, being the Remainder of Erf 1034, Swellendam, situated in the Municipality and Administrative District of Swellendam, in extent one thousand three hundred (1 300) square metres.

Deed of Transfer 28632/1985, dated 7 August 1985.

10. ALMARDE HOMESTEAD, SONSKYN, IN THE WORCESTER DISTRICT

The historic Almarde homestead, consisting of all the buildings within the ring-wall, the ring-wall itself, and the nearby thatched cottage, situated on a portion of certain piece of redemeed quitrent land in the Division of Worcester, being the farm Sonskyn 299.

11. THE PALINGGAT HOMESTEAD AND THE PALING FOUNTAIN, PLATTE BOSCH, STILL BAY DISTRICT

Description:

The historic Palinggat homestead and the nearby paling fountain, each with 20 metres of surrounding land, situated on Portion 57 (a portion of Portion 56) of the farm Plate Bosch 485, situated in the Municipality of Still Bay, Division of Riversdale.

12. THE VICTORIAN DWELLING-HOUSE, LANGLEY ROAD, WYNBERG, CAPE TOWN

Description:

The property together with the Victorianian dwelling-house thereon, being the Remainder of Erf 67076, Cape Town at Wynberg, situated in the City of Cape Town, Cape Division, in extent six hundred and six (606) square metres.

Deed of Transfer T31381/1985, dated 27 August 1985.

13. DUTCH REFORMED CHURCH BUILDING AND CHURCH BELL, ADENDORP, GRAAFF-REINET DISTRICT

Description:

The property, inclusive of the Dutch Reformed Church building and the Church bell thereon, described as certain piece of land, situated in the Village of Adendorp, Division of Graaff-Reinet, being land reserved for the Church (now known as Erf 1145, Adendorp).
