7. THE FRIEDENSKIRCHE, TWIST STREET, JOHANNESBURG

*Description:*

The church known as the Friedenskirche, situated on certain Stand 4688, situated in the Township of Johannesburg, District of Johannesburg, in extent 4925 (four thousand nine hundred and twenty-five) square metres.
