DECLARATION OF PROPERTIES AS NATIONAL MONUMENTS

By virtue of the powers vested in me by Section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Frederik Willem de Klerk, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the properties as fully described in the Annexure hereto to be national monuments.

ANNEXURE

1. THE XII MILESTONE AND THE OLD OIL LAMP, CORNER OF VOORTREKKER AND DURBAN ROADS, BELLVILLE

Description:

(a) The XII milestone consists of a rectangular solid block of bluestone with a triangular top and the Roman figures XII engraved on the face thereof.

(b) The old Victorian oil lamp consists of a hexagonal cast-iron lamp post with a four-sided lantern mounted thereon and crowned with a solidly cast newel decoration.

The milestone, as well as the oil lamp, is situated on a portion of land on the corner of Voortrekker and Durban Roads, in the Township of Bellville, Division of Cape Town, being a portion of unregistered municipal townlands.

2. THE FACADES OF THE TRINITY METHODIST CHURCH, DUDLEY HALL AND WESLEY MANSE, TOGETHER WITH THE CAST-IRON FENCE AROUND THESE BUILDINGS, SITUATED IN CALEDON STREET, GRAAFF-REINET

The facades of the three Methodist Church buildings, consisting of the Trinity Church, the so-called Dudley Hall and the dwelling-house known as Weşley Manse,
