DECLARATION OF PROPERTIES AS
NATIONAL MONUMENTS

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Frederik Willem de Klerk, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the properties as fully described in the Annexure hereto, to be national monuments.

FOURTEEN DWELLING-HOUSES: THE SO-CALLED JAN RUPERT CENTRE BUILDING; THE REINET MUSEUM BUILDING; THE OLD JEWISH CEMETERY AND THE FACADES OF TWENTY-FOUR DWELLING-HOUSES, SITUATED IN THE HISTORICAL CORE OF GRAAFF-REINET

(i) No. 1 Bourke Street, Graaff-Reinet

Description:

The facade of the Victorian dwelling-house situated on the Remainder of Erf 202, Graaff-Reinet, in the Municipality and Division of Graaff-Reinet, in extent 508 (five hundred and eight) square metres.

Deed of Transfer T. 26650/1983, dated 14 July 1983.

(ii) Nos. 39, 41, 43, 45 and 47 Bourke Street, Graaff-Reinet

Description:

The facades of the five Georgian cottages situated on the following erven:

Erf 1213, Graaff-Reinet, situate in the Municipality and Division of Graaff-Reinet, in extent 132 (one hundred and thirty-two) square metres;

Erf 1214, Graaff-Reinet, situate as above, in extent 142 (one hundred and forty-two) square metres;
