

2. THE PRETORIUSKLOOF NATURE RESERVE AND WALL OF THE LOCH ATHLONE DAM, SITUATED AT BETHLEHEM

Description:

The nature reserve known as Pretoriuskloof, together with the wall of the Loch Athlone Dam, described as follows:

The figure A B C D E F G H J K L M N O P Q R S T U V' middle of river W' X Y Z A' B' C' D' E' F' G' H' J' K' L' M' represents approximately 41,6 hectares of land, being a national monument site on the following properties:

- (a) A portion of the Remainder of the farm Pretorius Kloof 152 (Grant 35783/1888, dated 8 November 1888);
- (b) a portion of the Remainder of the farm Cambridge 1669 (Deed of Transfer T6449/1987, dated 9 July 1987);
- (c) a portion of the farm Bethlehem Reservoir 1678 (Deed of Transfer 493/1925, dated 19 February 1925);
- (d) a portion of Erf 3023, Bethlehem (unregistered municipal townlands);
- (e) a portion of Erf 228, Bethlehem (Deed of Transfer 5113/1927, dated 23 November 1927);
- (f) Erf 587, Bethlehem (Deed of Transfer 2168/1933, dated 15 November 1933),

situated in the Administrative District of Bethlehem, Province of the Orange Free State, as shown on Surveyor's Diagram LG 331/1984, dated 19 June 1984, and filed in the Office of the Surveyor-General in Bloemfontein.

3. THE PROPERTY, TOGETHER WITH THE OLD TOWN HOUSE THEREON, SITUATED IN ROUX STREET, ROUXVILLE

Description:

The property, together with the old town house thereon, being certain Remaining Extent of Erf 31, situated in the Town and District of Rouxville, in extent two hundred and sixty-eight (268) square metres.

Deed of Transfer T12388/1980, dated 30 September 1980.

4. THE FACADES OF THE STANDARD BANK BUILDING, THE TOWN HALL, THE PUBLIC LIBRARY, THE SO-CALLED ELLIOTTS BUILDING AND THE CATHCART FRUITERS BUILDING, SITUATED IN MAIN STREET, CATHCART

The facade of the Standard Bank building situated in Main Street, Cathcart.

Description:

The facade of the Standard Bank building, situated on a certain piece of land, in the Town and Division of Cathcart, being subdivision 1 of Lot 74 M.A. portion of Lot 74, Block M. (now known as Erf 265, Cathcart).

Deed of Transfer 15896/1919, dated 31 December 1919 (endorsement p. 1).

The facade of the Town Hall situated in Main Street, Cathcart.
