DECLARATION OF PROPERTIES TO BE
NATIONAL MONUMENTS

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act No. 28 of 1969), I, Frederik Willem de Klerk, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the properties as fully described in the Annexure hereto to be national monuments.

1. THE PROPERTY WITH THE SO-CALLED KINGS COURT THEREON, SITUATED AT 2 CHURCH STREET, DURBANVILLE

Description:

The property, together with the so-called Kings Court thereon, situate on a portion of the remainder of Erf 1755, Durbanville, in the Municipality of Durbanville, Division of the Cape, and in extent 861 (eight hundred and sixty-one) square metres, as detailed by the figure A B C D E on Survey Diagram SG 1012-88, dated 23 May 1988, and filed in the Office of the Surveyor-General at Cape Town and on File 2/K/Dur/5 in the Office of the National Monuments Council in Cape Town.
