

2. THE SO-CALLED CAMPANILE, SITUATED AT THE ORIGINAL HARBOUR ENTRANCE, AT PORT ELIZABETH CENTRAL

Description:

The so-called Campanile, situate on a certain piece of unregistered municipal land in the City of Port Elizabeth, now described as Erf 4457, Port Elizabeth Central, situate in the Municipality and Administrative District of Port Elizabeth, Province of the Cape of Good Hope, in extent 49 (forty-nine) square metres, as detailed by the figure A B C D on Survey Diagram SG 7092-87, dated 24 March 1988, filed in the Office of the Surveyor-General in Cape Town and on File 3/K/Port E/23 in the Office of the National Monuments Council in Cape Town.

3. THE FORMER WINE-CELLAR, SLAVE QUARTERS AND DWELLING-HOUSE SITUATED AT SAREL CILLIERS STREET, NAPIER

Description:

The former wine-cellar, slave quarters and dwelling-house, situate on a portion of Erf 875 (a portion of Erf 89), Napier, in the Municipality of Napier, Division of Bredasdorp.

Deed of Transfer T22311/1988, dated 28 April 1988.

4. THE ORIGINAL CITY HALL BUILDING AND THE SETTLERS' MEMORIAL TOWER, SITUATED IN HIGH STREET, GRAHAMSTOWN

Description:

The original City Hall building, together with the Settlers' Memorial Tower, situate on a portion of certain erf or lot of land marked No. 3, in the Municipality of the City of Grahamstown, Division of Albany (now known as Erf 1919, Grahamstown).

Deed of Transfer 194/1865, dated 14 July 1865 (endorsement p. 2).

5. THE SO-CALLED MIMOSA LODGE (PREVIOUSLY KNOWN AS THE SLADOWSKI HOUSE), SITUATED AT 85 BARON VAN RHEEDE STREET, OUDTSHOORN

Description:

The property, together with the so-called Mimosa Lodge (previously known as the Sladowski House) thereon, being the remainder of Erf 816, Oudtshoorn, situate in the Municipality and Division of Oudtshoorn, in extent 4 094 (four thousand and ninety-four) square metres.

Deed of Transfer T27422/85, dated 31 July 1985.

6. THE SO-CALLED SWARTBERG HOTEL, SITUATED AT 77 CHURCH STREET, PRINCE ALBERT

Description:

The so-called Swartberg Hotel, excluding the (1952) rondawels, situated on portions of the following erven:

- (i) Certain piece of land, being the remainder of Erf 193, Prince Albert, situate in Church Street, in the Municipality and Division of Prince Albert, being a reteable area in the Kweekvallei Irrigation Board District; and
