DECLARATION OF PROPERTIES TO BE NATIONAL MONUMENTS

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act No. 28 of 1969), I, Roelof Petrus Meyer, Deputy Minister of Constitutional Development and of National Education, hereby declare the property as fully described in the Schedule hereto to be national monuments.

THE OLD METHODIST CHAPEL AT NCERA, KIDDS BEACH, EAST LONDON

Description:

The old Methodist chapel, situate on a portion of Portion 1 of the farm Richmond 1024, in the Division of East London.

2. THE PROPERTY WITH THE DUTCH REFORMED CHURCH BUILDING THERE-ON, SITUATED IN STEYN STREET, VEN-TERSBURG

Description:

The property, together with the Dutch Reformed Church building thereon, being Erf 96, bounded by and situated at Steyn, Church, Orange and Harker Streets, in the Town of Ventersburg, District of Winburg, in extent 2 578 (two thousand five hundred and seventy-eight) square metres.

Deed of Transfer 23244/1880, dated 9 June 1880.

THE SITE, WITH THE THREE HISTORIC CORRUGATED-IRON HOUSES THEREON, SITUATED AT 3, 4 AND 5 JACOBUS NAUDÉ ROAD, VOORTREKKER-HOOGTE, PRETORIA

Description:

The site, with the three historic corrugatediron houses thereon, situate on a portion of the remainder of Portion 7 of the farm Pretoria Town and Townlands 351 JR, Province of the Transvaal, in extent 7 141 square metres, as indicated by the figure ABCD on Survey Diagram SG A5323/87, dated 17 August 1987, filed in the Office of the Surveyor-General in Pretoria, and on File 2/T/Pre/21 at the National Monuments Council in Cape Town.
