

12. THE KIMBERLEY MASONIC TEMPLE SITUATED IN DUTOITSPAN ROAD KIMBERLEY

*Description:*

The Kimberley Masonic Temple, situated on certain Erf 13991, Kimberley, in the Municipality and Administrative District of Kimberley.

13. THE MORAVIAN CHURCH AND PARSONAGE, SITUATED ON THE SO-CALLED MORAVIAN HILL IN ZONNEBLOEM CAPE TOWN

The Moravian church and parsonage situated on portions of Erf 9918, Cape Town in the City of Cape Town.

16. THE DOUBLE-STOREYED GEORGIAN BUILDING KNOWN AS HET STICHT, AT SIMONDIUM, PAARL
