THE ORIGINAL VALKENBERG HOSPITAL BUILDING COMPLEX (1899), CONSISTING OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE BLOCK (EXTERIOR AND INTERIOR), THE COURTYARDS, THE EXTERNAL FACADES OF THE BUILDINGS DESIGNATED BLOCKS F.I, F.II, F.III, F.IV, F.V, M.I, M.II, M.III, M.IV AND M.V, THE STORES BUILDING AND THE LAUNDRY BUILDING, AT OBSERVATORY, CAPE TOWN

Description

The original Valkenberg Hospital building complex (1899), consisting of the Administrative Block (exterior and interior), the courtyards, the external facades of the buildings designated Blocks F.I, F.II, F.III, F.IV, F.V, M.I, M.II, M.III, M.IV AND M.V, the stores building and the laundry building, situated on the farm Perseel Swart River (now known as the remainder of Erf 26439, Cape Town at Observatory), situated at Mowbray, in ~~Cape Town at Observatory~~, situated at Mowbray, in the Municipality of Cape Town, Division of the Cape, Province of the Cape of Good Hope.
