

NATIONAL MONUMENTS ACT,  
No. 28 OF 1969DECLARATION OF PROPERTIES TO BE  
NATIONAL MONUMENTS

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act No. 28 of 1969), I, Theodorus Gerhardus Alant, Deputy Minister of National Education, hereby declare the properties as fully described in the Schedule hereto to be national monuments.

**SCHEDULE**1. THE HISTORIC DWELLINGS AT 74 AND 76  
LOMBARD STREET, POTCHEFSTROOM*Description:*(a) *74 Lombard Street*

The historic dwelling together with 12 metres of land on the northern side, 13 metres on the southern side, 4 metres on the eastern side and 2,5 metres on the western side of the building, situated on Remaining Extent of Portion 3 (a Portion of Portion 2) of Erf 75, in the Township of Potchefstroom, Registration Division IQ, Transvaal.

Deed of Transfer T44525/1983, dated 25 October 1983.

(b) *76 Lombard Street*

The historic house, together with 12 metres of land on the northern side, 13 metres on the southern side, 4 metres on the western side and 2,8 metres on the eastern side of the building, situated on Remaining Extent of Portion 2 of Erf 75, in the Town Potchefstroom, Registration Division IQ, Transvaal.

Deed of Transfer T767/1984, dated 1 June 1984.

2. THE DOUBLE-STOREYED DWELLING KNOWN  
AS ARMAGH, SITUATED AT 40 MEMORIAL  
ROAD, KIMBERLEY*Description:*

The double-storeyed dwelling known as *Armagh*, including the garden in front of the building and 10 metres of land at the rear thereof, situated on Erf 881, Kimberley, in the Municipality of the City of Kimberley, Division of Kimberley.

Deed of Transfer T540/1990, dated 30 March 1990.
