

3. THE EASTERN TERMINAL POINT BEACON OF SIR THOMAS MACLEAR'S ZWARTLAND SURVEY BASE-LINE, ON THE FARM EENDRAG, IN THE MALMESBURY DISTRICT

*Description:*

The eastern terminal point beacon of Sir Thomas Maclear's Zwartland survey base-line, together with four metres of surrounding land, situated on Portion 10 of the farm Geelekuil 432 (now known as the farm Eendrag), in the Division of Malmesbury.

Deed of Transfer T9744/1991, dated 19 February 1991.

4. THE FOUR HISTORIC WATER WHEELS, SITUATED ON ERVEN 103, 1057, 68 AND 1467, ALONG THE NORTHERN FURROW OF THE IRRIGATION CANAL AT THE KAKAMAS SOUTH SETTLEMENT, IN THE DIVISION OF KENHARDT

*Description:*

The four historic water wheels along the northern furrow of the irrigation canal at the Kakamas South Settlement, situated on the following erven:

(i) Erf 103, situated in the Village of Kakamas South Settlement, Division of Kenhardt.

(ii) Erf 1057, situated in the Village of Kakamas South Settlement, Division of Kenhardt.

Deed of Transfer 11280/1990, dated 28 February 1990 (par. 1);

(iii) Erf 68, situated in the Village of Kakamas, South Settlement, Division of Kenhardt.

Deed of Transfer 14240/1968, dated 5 July 1968 (par. 2); and

(iv) Erf 1467, situated in the Village of Kakamas South Settlement, Division of Kenhardt.

Deed of Transfer 51668/1988, dated 5 September 1988 (par. 2).

5. THE SCHOOL BUILDING OF THE PIETERMARITZBURG MUSIC SCHOOL (ORIGINALLY THE HARWARD BOYS' SCHOOL AND LATER THE COLLEGE FOR FURTHER TRAINING), SITUATED IN HAVELOCK STREET, IN PIETERMARITZBURG

*Description:*

The school building of the Pietermaritzburg Music School (originally the Harward Boys' School and later the College for Further Training), situated on certain piece of land, being Subdivision D of Outspan No. 3 of Pietermaritzburg, Province of Natal.

Deed of Transfer T3599/1920, dated 4 August 1920.
