

5. THE DUMORTIERITE OCCURENCE ON THE FARM N'ROUGAS NOORD, DISTRICT OF KENHARDT

*Description*

The dumortierite occurrence, situated on a portion of certain piece of land known as N'Rougas Oost, a portion of N'Rougas Noord, situated in the Administrative District and Division of Kenhardt, in extent 4 896 square metres, as indicated by the figure A B C D on Survey Diagram SG 5416/89, dated 12 September 1989, filed in the office of the Surveyor-General at Cape Town and on File 9/2/048/4 in the office of the National Monuments Council at Cape Town.

Deed of Transfer T40381/1975, dated 18 December 1975.

6. THE SO-CALLED *LOCH BRIDGE* OVER THE KRAAI RIVER, SITUATED ON THE FARM TYGER KRANTZ, DIVISION OF BARKLY EAST

*Description*

The so-called *Loch Bridge* over the Kraai River, situated on a portion of certain abolished quitrent land, being Portion 2 of the farm Tyger Krantz 139, in the Division of Barkly East.

Deed of Transfer T25265/1974, dated 6 August 1974.

7. THE HISTORIC OLD WATER WHEEL (No. 2), SITUATED ON LOT 103, ALONG THE NORTHERN FURROW OF THE CANAL AT THE KAKAMAS SOUTH SETTLEMENT, DIVISION OF KENHARDT

*Description*

The historic old water wheel (No. 2), situated on a portion of land, being Lot 103 (portion of Lot 232) of the farm Kakamas-Suid, in the Division of Kenhardt.

Deed of Transfer 20361/1960, dated 22 December 1960 (par. 2).

8. THE CITY HALL IN OXFORD STREET, EAST LONDON

*Description*

The City Hall, situated on a portion of certain piece of land, being Waterloo Square (now known as Erf 15274), situated in Ward 3, in the City of East London, Division of East London.

East London Freeholds 18/21, dated 10 March 1905.

9. JONKERHUIS, RIEBEECK LAKE, RANDFONTEIN

*Description*

The Jonkerhuis, together with 2,5 metres of land to the northern side, 5 metres of land to the western and eastern sides, and 10 metres of land to the southern side of the building, situated on certain Portion 95 of the farm Randfontein 11, in the District of Randfontein (formerly No. 3, District of Krugersdorp).

Deed of Transfer T886/1954, dated 16 January 1954.
