PROCLAMATION OF A MONUMENT.

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 8 (1) (a) of the Natural and Historical Monuments, Relics and Antiques Act, 1934 (Act No.4 of 1934), I hereby proclaim the Strooidakkerk, Paarl, including the ground on which it is situated, to be a monument.

DESCRIPTION.

The Strooidakkerk, Dutch Reformed Church, Paarl.

Certain unregistered portion of Erf No. 2246, Paarl, with the buildings thereon, measuring 73.310 square feet, being a Historical Monument Site on portion of Erf No. 2246, Paarl, situate in the Municipality and Administrative

District of Paarl, Province of the Cape of Good Hope, as shown in Diagram S.G. No. 4444/66, dated 8th July, 1966, surveyed by Surveyor J. E. Duxbury in May, 1966.

HISTORICAL INTEREST.

The Strooidakkerk, Paarl, was consecrated in 1805 and is one of the oldest Dutch Reformed Church buildings, still in use, in the Republic.

It has a great tradition and its architectural merit is considerable.
