

3. DORCHESTER HOUSE AT 190 LOOP STREET, PIETERMARITZBURG

Description

The so-called Dorchester House, together with the portion of land between Loop Street and a parallel line running five metres from the rear of the house, situated on Sub. 5 of Lot 2719, Pietermaritzburg, in the City of Pietermaritzburg, Administrative District of Natal.

Deed of Transfer T1159/1986, dated 23 January 1986.

4. CONSERVATOIRE DE HAMMERSTEIN, 141 ALEXANDRA ROAD, PIETERMARITZBURG

Description

The building known as the Conservatoire de Hammerstein with four metres of surrounding land and the area between the building and Alexandra Road, situated on the Remainder of Erf 904, Pietermaritzburg.

5. THE PROPERTY WITH THE HISTORICAL BUILDING THEREON, AT 78 STOCKENSTRÖM STREET, WORCESTER

Description

The property with the historical building thereon, being the Remainder of Erf 1596, Worcester, in the Municipality and Division of Worcester, in extent 334 (three hundred and thirty-four) square metres.

6. A PORTION OF THE OLD MAIN ROAD BETWEEN GEORGE AND KNYSNA, SITUATED IN THE GEORGE DISTRICT

Description

That portion of the old main road between George and Knysna (No. 355) which stretches from a point directly opposite the turn-off to the Saasveld College on the property Saasveld 149 to the intersection with the main road from Hoekwil and Wilderness (No. 352), including the bridges over the Kaaimans, Silver and Touw Rivers, a total distance of about eleven kilometres.
