No. 384] PROCLAMATION OF A MONUMENT.

[23 March 1967.

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 8 (1) (a) of the Natural and Historical Monuments, Relics and Antiques Act (Act No.4 of 1934), I hereby proclaim a piece of land, with the buildings thereon, being the Rectory and Hall of the Church of the Province of South Africa, Bredasdorp, to be a monument.

DESCRIPTION.

The Rectory and Hall, Church of the Province of the South Africa, Bredasdorp.

The piece of land, with the buildings thereon, situate at the corner of Independent and Dirkie Uys Streets, measuring 100 feet by 100 feet, being a portion of certain piece of land situate at Bredasdorp in the Division of Swellendam, being part of the land marked La M (now known as Erf No. 707, Bredasdorp), measuring 143 square roods 8 square feet.

HISTORICAL INTEREST.

The Rectory and the former Anglican Church, now a hall, date from the earliest years of the town. The Rectory is a very fine Old Cape thatched house.
