(b) upon failure of such person to comply with such notice, put right or cause to be put right the result of the act of which he was found guilty and recover the costs thereof from such
(a) by notice in writing served upon such person by post or by delivery to him personally, direct him to put right the act of which he was found guilty as may be specified by the manner and within such period as may be so specified; and
8.2 Whenever any person has been convicted of any contravention or failure to comply with a by-law, the Municipality or the Council may—
<ol> <li>PENALTIES</li> <li>Any person who contravenes or fails to comply with a by-law shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding R100 (one hundred rand).</li> </ol>
A.2 Any person who considers that the Local Authority has granted a permit in contravention of by-law 6.8, may appeal within seven days of the date of issue of such permit to the Council. The Council may, after consultation with the Local Authority, confirm or revoke such permit and direct the Local Authority to issue a permit subject to such conditions as the Council may determine.
7.1 When the Local Authority has refused an application or granted a permit subject to conditions, the applicant may appeal against the decision to the Council. The Council may, after consultation with the Local Authority, confirm such decision or direct the Local Authority to grant the application, subject to such conditions as the Council may determine.
