PROCLAMATION OF A MONUMENT.

I, Johannes de Klerk, Minister of Education, Arts and Science, under and by virtue of the powers vested in me by section 8 (1) (a) of the Natural and Historical Monuments, Relics and Antiques Act, 1934 (Act No. 4 of 1934), hereby proclaim the bridge over the Vaal River at Barkly West to be a monument.

DESCRIPTION.

A bridge with its southerly abutment on the remainder of the farm Pniel No. 281, Division of Barkly West (B/W Quits 1/7) and the northerly abutment on remainder of Erf 687, Municipalty and Division of Barkly West (B/W Freeholds 1/20).

HISTORICAL INTEREST.

This bridge was built in the last quarter of the 19th century as a private undertaking and played an important part in the development of the region beyond the Vaal River.
