

NATIONAL MONUMENTS ACT, No. 28 OF 1969

ENTRIES IN THE REGISTER OF IMMOVABLE CONSERVATION-WORTHY PROPERTY

In terms of section 5 (1) (cC) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act No. 28 of 1969), the National Monuments Council hereby enters in the official register the immovable property as fully described in the Schedule hereto, and which the Council regards as conservation-worthy on account of its historical, cultural or aesthetic interest.

SCHEDULE

1. The Victorian dwelling known as the Bredell farmhouse, situated on the Remainder of Portion 6 of Farm 1088, Stellenbosch District.
2. The property with the building complex known as Die Werf thereon, being Erf 7153, at 53, 53A, 57 and 59 Bain Street, in Wellington.
3. The property with the house thereon, being Erf 1176, at 97 Central Road, Kimberley.
4. The property with the house thereon, being Erf 1162, at 7 Carrington Road, Kimberley.
5. The building complex known as the Old Bisho's Hostel, Kimberley Boys' High School, situated on Erf 899, Kimberley.
