VERKLARING VAN DIE HISTORIESE ST HELENAFONTEIN-PLAASHUIS IN DIE DISTRIK PIKETBERG

Kragtens die bevoegdheid my verleen by artikel 10 (1) van die Wet op Nasionale Gedenkwaardighede, 1969 (Wet 28 van 1969), verklaar ek, Gerrit van Niekerk Viljoen, Minister van Nasionale Opvoeding, hierby die laat-Georgiaanse dubbelverdiepingwoonhuis geleë op die plaas St Helenafontein in die distrik Piketberg, tot nasionale gedenkwaardigheid.

*Beskrywing*

Die laat-Georgiaanse dubbelverdiepingwoonhuis, geleë op sekere grond in die afdeling Piketberg, synde die restant van die plaas St Helenafontein A en groot eenduisend vier-honderd en sewentien komma ses agt een vyf (1 417,6815) hektaar.

*Historiese en argitektoniese belang*

Die oorspronklike St Helenafonteinplaashuis is vermoedelik in 1835 deur Pierre Rocher opgerig. In die tagtigerjare van die vorige eeu het 'n tweede verdieping die spitsdak vervang en is die gebou in die Georgiaanse styl omskep. 10/2/886.

NATIONAL MONUMENTS ACT, No. 28 OF 1969

DECLARATION OF THE HISTORIC ST HELENAFONTEIN FARMHOUSE IN THE PIKETBERG DISTRICT

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Gerrit van Niekerk Viljoen, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the late Georgian double-storeyed dwelling-house situated on the farm St Helenafontein in the Piketberg District, to be a national monument.

*Description*

The late Georgian double-storeyed dwelling-house, situate on certain land in the Division of Piketberg, being the remainder of the farm St Helenafontein A and measuring one thousand four hundred and seventeen comma six eight one five (1 417,6815) hectares.

Deed of Transfer 9988/1971, dated 20 April 1971.

*Historical and architectural interest*

The original St Helenafontein farmhouse was presumably erected in 1835 by Pierre Rocher. In the 1880s a second storey replaced the pitched roof and the building was converted to the Georgian style. 10/2/886.
