

(ii) *School Tie.*

On a royal blue background, at intervals of $2\frac{1}{8}$ inches, a combination of diagonal stripes, old gold—white—green, respectively $\frac{1}{8}$ inch, $\frac{1}{4}$ inch and $\frac{1}{8}$ inch in width.

(iii) *Rugby Jersey.*

Royal blue with white collar and cuffs.

(iv) *Rugby Stockings.*

Royal blue with turnover in white, 7 inches wide.

(v) *School Stockings.*

Grey with turnover consisting of horizontal stripes, grey—royal blue—green—white—old gold—royal blue—grey, seen from below, respectively $1\frac{1}{4}$ inches, $\frac{1}{2}$ inch, $\frac{1}{4}$ inch, $\frac{1}{2}$ inch, $\frac{1}{4}$ inch, $\frac{1}{2}$ inch and $2\frac{3}{4}$ inches in width.

Coat of Arms or Badge.

On a Swiss type of shield with a bordure consisting of a combination of vert, argent and Or (viewed inward from the exterior), azure, a bridge Or, masoned sable, consisting of one arch which rests at either end on four horizontal bars argent. In the lower section, to wit from beneath the bridge to the base of the shield, azure, wavy bars fess-wise argent, symbolising waters which are bridged here, from both a literal and figurative point of view.

Above the shield the name of the school is given by initials Or: C.H.S.

For a motto, on a scroll azure, edged Or, in letters of the same: WAKKER EN GETROU.

6. *Name.*—Cape Town Cricket Club.*Coat of Arms or Badge.*

On a circular field Or, an anchor erect sable, from the top of which appears a riband flowing azure, crossed argent. Superimposed on the anchor is an inescutcheon gules, charged with three annulets Or, placed 2 and 1.

Below the circular field appear, in Gothic style, the initials of the name of the above-mentioned club: C.T.C.C.

Tie.—On a mid-grey background at intervals of 1 inch, a series of diagonal stripes, old gold, mid-grey, bright cherry, mid-grey and old gold, respectively $\frac{1}{16}$ inch, $\frac{3}{32}$ inch, $\frac{1}{8}$ inch, $\frac{3}{32}$ inch and $\frac{1}{16}$ inch in width.

(ii) *Skooldas.*

Op 'n koningsblou agtergrond en met tussenruimtes van $2\frac{1}{8}$ duim, 'n samestelling van diagonale strepe, ougoud—wit—groen, onderskeidelik $\frac{1}{8}$ duim, $\frac{1}{4}$ duim en $\frac{1}{8}$ duim breed.

(iii) *Voetbaltrui.*

Koningsblou met wit kraag en punte.

(iv) *Voetbalkouse.*

Koningsblou met wit omslag, breed.

(v) *Skoolkouse.*

In grys, met 'n omslag bestaande uit horisontale strepe, grys—koningsblou—wit—ougoud—koningsblou—grys, van onderaf gesien, onderskeidelik $\frac{1}{8}$ duim, $\frac{1}{4}$ duim, $\frac{1}{2}$ duim, $\frac{1}{4}$ duim, en $2\frac{3}{4}$ duim breed.

Wapen of kenteken.

Op 'n Switserse tipe skild met 'n saamgestelde omsoming van groen, silwer en goud (van buite na binne gesien), in blou, 'n brug van goud met swart messelwerk, bestaande uit 'n enkele boog met aan weerskante op vier horisontaalgeplaaste silwerblokke rus. In die onderste verdeling, te wete van onder die brug tot aan die skildpunt, in blou, golwende dwarsbalke van silwer, simboliserende waters, in letterlike en figuurlike sin, wat hier oorbrug word.

Bokant die skild word die naam van die skool in voorletters in goud, aangedui: C.H.S.

As wapenspreuk staan op 'n blou lint met goudomlyning, in goue letters: WAKKER EN GETROU.
