PROKLAMERING VAN 'N GEDENKWAARDIGHEID.

Kragtens die bevoegdheid my verleen by paragraaf (a) 1 subartikel (1) van artikel *agt* van die Wet op Natuurlike en Historiese Gedenkwaardighede en Oudhede, 1934 (Wet No. 4 van 1934), soos gewysig, proklameer ek hierby die Eerste Huis, Port Elizabeth, as 'n gedenkwaardigheid.

BESKRYWING.

Eerste Huis, Port Elizabeth.—'n Sekere gedeelte vryergrond, geleë in die munisipale gebied van die stad Port Elizabeth, Afdeling Port Elizabeth, binne die Garnisoenterrein, t.w. die perseel gemerk No. 9 (tans bekend as Erf No. 3987, Port Elizabeth Sentraal).

HISTORIESE BELANG.

Die huis, Castle Hill No. 7, is in 1825 vir Eerw. Francis McClelland, die eerste Koloniale Kapelaan in Port Elizabeth gebou. Dit is 'n goeie voorbeeld van die vroeë 19de-eeuse dorpshuis in die Oostelike Provinsie. Dit is een van die eerste stewige geboue wat in Algoabaai opgerig is en is blykbaar die oudste woonhuis.

H2/1/1301.—Die naam en uniform van die Theunissenhoërskool, soos gepubliseer by Goewermentskennisgewing No. 744 van 22 September 1961.

H2/1/1357.—Die naam en wapen van die Suid-Transvaalse Ringtennis-unie, soos gepubliseer by Goewermentskennisgewing No. 743 van 22 September 1961, gelees met Goewermentskennisgewing No. 40 van 12 Januarie 1962.

H2/1/1425.—Die naam en wapen van die Hoër Handelskool, Belgravia, Johannesburg, soos gepubliseer by Goewermentskennisgewing No. 786 van 29 September 1961.

H2/1/1448.—Die naam en uniform van die Florida-Afrikaansmediumhoërskool, soos gepubliseer by Goewermentskennisgewing No. 746 van 22 September 1961.

PROCLAMATION OF A MONUMENT.

By virtue of the powers vested in me by paragraph (a) of sub-section (1) of section *eight* of the Natural and Historical Monuments, Relics and Antiques Act, 1934 (Act No. 4 of 1934), as amended, I hereby proclaim to be a monument the First House, Port Elizabeth.

DESCRIPTION.

First House, Port Elizabeth.—Certain piece of freehold land situate in the Municipality of the City of Port Elizabeth, Division of Port Elizabeth, within the limits of the Garrison Ground, being the Lot marked No. 19 (now known as Erf No. 3987, Port Elizabeth Central).

HISTORICAL INTEREST.

The house, No. 7 Castle Hill, was built in 1825 for the Rev. Francis McClelland, first Colonial Chaplain in Port Elizabeth. It is an excellent example of early 19th century town houses in the Eastern Province. It is among the earliest substantial buildings to be erected at Algoa Bay and is evidently the oldest dwelling.
