**PARTIAL WITHDRAWAL OF RESERVATION OF
LAND FOR THE PURPOSE OF A TOWNSHIP**

The State President has, by virtue of the powers vested in him, withdrawn the reservation of land for the purpose of a township set out in Government Notice 19 of 1954, published in *Government Gazette* 5208 of 8 January 1954, in so far as it relates to Subdivision 12, in extent approximately 35,980 7 hectares, and Subdivision 13, in extent approximately 28,514 6 hectares, situate on the farm Virginia 15, Administrative District of Ventersburg, Mining District of the Orange Free State, Province of the Orange Free State, and as shown on sketch plans, copies of which have been filed in the Mining Titles Office, Johannesburg, and in the office of the Mining Commissioner: O.F.S., Welkom, under RMT R5/76 and RMT R6/76, respectively.

DECLARATION OF A NATIONAL MONUMENT

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Pieter Gerhardus Jacobus Koornhof, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the Remainder of Erf 3918, with historic building thereon, situate at 1 Cora Terrace, Port Elizabeth, to be a national monument.

Description

Certain piece of land, with the historic building thereon, situate in the Municipality of the City of Port Elizabeth, Division of Port Elizabeth, being the Remainder of Erf 3918, Port Elizabeth Central, and measuring as such two hundred and sixty-eight (268) square metres.

Historical and architectural interest

The houses in Cora Terrace are outstanding examples of Victorian architecture and contribute to the traditional aspect of this particular portion of Port Elizabeth. 10/2/430.
