

NATIONAL MONUMENTS ACT, No. 28 OF 1969

ENTRIES IN THE REGISTER OF IMMOVABLE CONSERVATION-WORTHY PROPERTY

In terms of section 5 (1) (cC) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act No. 28 of 1969), the National Monuments Council hereby enters in the official register the immovable properties as fully described in the Schedule hereto, and which the Council regards as conservation-worthy on account of its historical, cultural or aesthetic interest.

SCHEDULE

1. The property with the house known as *Riversyde* thereon, being Portion 1 of the Remainder of Farm 131, at 2 Long Street, Great Brak River, Mossel Bay District.
2. The property with the historical house thereon, being Erf 186, at 5 Max Harris Street, Grabouw, Caledon District.
3. The property with the buildings known as *Die Rondawel* and *Die Wit Huisie* thereon, being Erf 125, Jongensfontein, Still Bay District.
4. The building described as the Krommerivier Barn, situated on Erf 16263, at the corner of Hoffman and Kruger Streets, Stellenbosch.
