PROCLAMATION OF A MONUMENT.

By virtue of the powers vested in me by paragraph (a) of sub-section (1) of section *eight* of the Natural and Historical Monuments, Relics and Antiques Act, 1934 (Act No. 4 of 1934), as amended, I hereby proclaim to be a monument the Botanical Gardens, Cape Town.

DESCRIPTION.

Botanical Gardens, Cape Town: Bounded N.W. by Queen Victoria Street, N.E. by the Public Library property, S.E. by Government Avenue and S.W. by a road abutting the N.E. boundary of land resumed by the Colonial Government (Diagram No. 123/1901).
