PROCLAMATION OF A MONUMENT

I, Johannes de Klerk, Minister of National Education, under and by virtue of the powers vested in me by section 8 (1) (a) of the Natural and Historical Monuments, Relics and Antiques Act, 1934 (Act 4 of 1934), hereby proclaim the old irrigation tunnel and water furrow at Hankey, in the District of Humansdorp, to be a monument.

Description

Certain piece of land with the historic tunnel and water furrow on it, as shown in Diagram S.G. 9374/67, surveyed in November 1967 by surveyor R. J. Hemsley.

Historical Interest

The old irrigation tunnel and the water furrow are a notable engineering work of pioneer farmers under the guidance of the Rev. William Philip. They were completed in 1844.
