## PROCLAMATION OF A MONUMENT

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 8 (1) (a) of the Natural and Historical Monuments, Relics and Antiques Act, 1934 (Act 4 of 1934), I, Johannes de Klerk, Minister of National Education, hereby proclaim the out-building of the old Parsonage at Burgersdorp, Cape Province, with the site on which it is situated, to be a monument.

## Description

Certain piece of ground with the building thereon, situate in the town of Burgersdorp, Division of Albert, being Lot A, portion of Erf 167 (now described as Erf 184 Burgersdorp) and measuring 25 square roods 72 square inches.

## Historical Interest

In this building the Theological Seminary of the Gereformeerde Kerk in Suid-Afrika was established in 1869. In 1905 this institution was moved to Potchefstroom where it eventually gave rise to the Potchefstroomse Universiteit vir Christelike Hoër Onderwys.
