THE NATURAL AND HISTORICAL MONUMENTS,
RELICS AND ANTIQUES ACT, 1934.—PROTECTION
OF MONUMENTS.

It is hereby notified for general information that the Minister of the Interior has been pleased, under the powers vested in him by section *eight* of the Natural and Historical Monuments, Relics and Antiques Act, 1934 (Act No. 4 of 1934), to proclaim the objects set out in the Schedule below to be monuments in terms of paragraph (a) of that section.

Piet Lafras Uys Monument, Utrecht	Utrecht.
Wild Fig Tree.....	At the First Outspan between Durban and Pietermaritzburg on the Main Road Reserve with encroachment on sub-division 11 of lot 47 of Wandsbeck No. 835.
Old Raadzaal, Vryheid, to include the Old Fort	Area in addition to that proclaimed in Government Notice No. 529 of 1936, to include the Old Fort and loopholed wall and strips of ground between the wall and the Old Raadzaal and bordering on the pavement between the Raadzaal and the fence separating the Public Library area.
Bloukrans Monument.....	Bloukrans, district Weenen, grondbrief No. 398/98 of rem. of rem. of Rama, Weenen and grondbrief No. 2909/31 sub. do. No. 2 of C. 2 of Rama, Weenen.

Pump House, Capetown....	Remainder of O.C.F. 38 of Lot 2A (C.T. 1079/24) corner of Prince and Sir George Grey Streets, Oranjezicht, Capetown.
Mooimeisjesfontein (Home of Piet Retief)	Figure marked abcdefgh representing 15 morgen, 196 square roods, 80 square feet of land in the Division of Albany being lot called the "Werf," situate in the extension of the village of Riebeeck East. Possession of the farm Mooimeisjesfontein granted to the Church Wardens or Consistory of the Dutch Reformed Church of Albany at Riebeeck East on the 1st April, 1910, No. 713/1912. General Plan R. 24d. Deducted No. 2133 of August 24th, 1912, and figure marked abcdefghijk representing 4 morgen, 598 square roods, 37 square feet of land in the Division of Albany, Field Cornetcy of Upper Riebeeck, being Block Q. 2 portion of the farm Mooimeisjesfontein, granted to the Church Wardens or Consistory of the Dutch Reformed Church of Albany at Riebeeck East on the 1st April, 1910 No. 712/1912. Deducted No. 2134 of August 24th, 1912.
