## PROCLAMATION OF A MONUMENT

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I. Cornelius Petrus Mulder, Acting Minister of National Education (Cultural Affairs), hereby proclaim the house in 53 Beaufort Street, Grahamstown, to be a monument.

## Description

Certain piece of freehold land, with the house thereon, situate in the Municipality of the City of Grahamstown, Division of Albany, being the remainder of Erf 1692, Grahamstown, and measuring (as such) 241 square roods 137 square feet and 96 square inches, (Diagram 124/1821 filed with registration duplicate of Albany Freeholds, Volume 1, page 32, dated 8.9.1821.)

## Historical Interest

This house is an outstanding example of an early nineteenth century Georgian dwelling in South Africa.
