**DECLARATION OF A NATIONAL MONUMENT**

Under section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Johannes Petrus van der Spuy, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the old wool mill at Bathurst to be a national monument.

*Description*

Certain piece of partly abolished quitrent land, including the building known as the old wool mill, situate in the Municipality and Division of Bathurst, being Erf 365, Bathurst, measuring 70,122 square feet (Deed of Transfer 27597/1965, dated 1.11.1965).

*Historical Interest*

This wool mill was built in 1821 by Samuel Bradshaw, an 1820 Settler. It played an important role in the history of the wool industry in South Africa.
