## DECLARATION OF A NATIONAL MONUMENT

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Johannes Petrus van der Spuy, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the old fishing harbour, including the old seawall, at Hermanus. to be a national monument.

## Description

- (a) The remainder of Erf 830, Hermanus, with the construction thereon, situate in the Municipality of Hermanus, Division of Caledon, Province of the Cape of Good Hope, and measuring, as such, 78 555 square feet (Crown Grant 72/1955, dated 22 March 1955).
- (b) The sea wall which extends from the above- mentioned Erf 830, in a southerly direction as shown in Cadastral Sheet  $\frac{AI-3CB}{v54}$

## Historical Interest

Hermanus owes its origin to the local fishing industry. For more than a century the old harbour served the fishermen and the community, and it is still a spectacular attraction.
