DECLARATION OF A NATIONAL MONUMENT

Under section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Johannes Petrus van der Spuy, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the Dutch Reformed Church in Donkin Street, Beaufort West, to be a national monument.

Description

The Dutch Reformed Church, situate on certain piece of land, Eif 12 in the town of Beaufort West (now known as Erf 582 Beaufort West), measuring 420 square roods and held under Beaufort West Freeholds, Volume 2, Folio 3, dated 17 September 1943.

Historica Interest

This church was built in 1826-1831 and enlarged in 1892-1894. It is well known for its architectural excellence.
