DECLARATION OF A NATIONAL MONUMENT

Under section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Johannes Petrus van der Spuy, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the house known as Groot Paardevlei, Somerset West, to be a national monument.

Description

The historic house known as Groot Paardevlei situate on certain piece of partly abolished quitrent and partly freehold land, being Portion 22, a portion of Portion 2 of the farm 774, Stellenbosch, situate near Somerset West, in the Division of Stellenbosch, measuring 1·6651 morgen and held under Deed of Transfer 19819/1966.

Historical Interest

The farm was granted to Frans van der Stel, youngest son of Governor Simon van der Stel, shortly after 1700. The farm was the property of Martin Melck when he died in 1781, and it was probably his widow who gave the house its H-shape. It retains many of its original architectural features. It was recently acquired by Historical Homes Limited for preservation.

DECLARATION OF A NATIONAL MONUMENT

Under section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Johannes Petrus van der Spuy, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the house known as Parel Vallei, Somerset West, to be a national monument.

Description

The historic house known as Parel Vallei situate on certain piece of partly freehold partly redeemed quitrent land, being the remaining extent of Parel Vallei A, a portion of Parel Vallei, situate at Somerset West, in the Division of Stellenbosch [now known as Portion 2 (Parel Vallei) of the consolidated farm Parel Vallei 753], measuring 54·3262 morgen and held under Deed of Transfer 25400/1967, dated 3 November 1967.

Historical Interest

The farm was granted to Frans van der Stel, youngest son of Governor Simon van der Stel, in 1699. The back and front gables were added to the house in 1800. It was damaged by fire early in this century and thereafter restored. It has recently been purchased for preservation by Historical Homes Limited.

Historiese Belang

Die plaas is kort na 1700 aan Frans van der Stel, jongste seun van goewerneur Simon van der Stel, toegeken.
