*Historiese en argitektoniese belang*

Enigeen wat teen die registrasie van hierdie heraldiese voorstelling beswaar wil aanteken op grond daarvan dat so 'n registrasie inbreuk sal maak op regte wat hom wettiglik toekom, moet dit doen binne twee weke vanaf die datum van publikasie van hierdie kennisgewing op 'n vorm wat van die Staatsheraldikus, Privaatsak X236, Pretoria, 0001, verkrygbaar is:

*Aansoeker.*—Departement van Doeane en Aksyns. (H4/3/3/34.)

*Wapen.*—In silwer, ondersteun van 'n blou kettinglose alhek versier van silwer, die middelste vertikale balk eileng en die ringe vervang deur oranje skywe, 'n Protea cynaroides blomkop van oranje, blou geblaar en saamsnoer, die geheel binne-in 'n skildsoom, alles van blou.

National Education, hereby declare Erf 152, Uniondale, with the historic Dutch Reformed Church building thereon, to be a national monument.

*Description*

Certain piece of redeemed quitrent land with the historic Dutch Reformed Church building thereon, situate in the Municipality and Division of Uniondale, being the remainder of a part of portion of the farm Rietvalley, now Erf 152, Uniondale, and measuring four hundred (400) square roods.

Deed of Transfer 15229/1948, dated 13 July 1948.

*Historical and architectural interest*

This church was erected in 1862, the style being predominantly neo-Gothic. It is closely connected with the history of the town. 10/2/503.

**DECLARATION OF A NATIONAL MONUMENT**

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Pieter Gerhardus Jacobus Koornhof, Minister of National Education, hereby declare Erf 4412, Queenstown, with the historic building of the Queenstown Museum thereon, to be a national monument.

*Description*

Certain piece of freehold land, with the historic building of the Queenstown Museum thereon, situate in the Municipality and Administrative District of Queenstown, being Erf 4412, Queenstown, and measuring one thousand seven hundred and thirty-one (1 731) square metres.

Certificate of Consolidated Title 38808/1976, dated 9 December 1976.

*Historical and architectural interest*

This building was originally erected in 1868 as a primary school. It is an outstanding example of a Victoria school building and is closely associated with the history of Queenstown. 10/2/506.

*Arms.*—Argent, supported by a portcullis Azure sans chains, garnished Argent, the central vertical beams extended and the rings replaced by two roundles Tenné, a Protea cynaroides flowerhead Tenné, leaved and banded, the whole within a bordure, Azure.
