DECLARATION OF A NATIONAL MONUMENT

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Pieter Gerhardus Jacobus Koornhof, Minister of National Education, hereby declare Queen's Park, East London, to be a national monument.

Description

The park, known as Queen's Park, East London, situate on that portion of Lot K1 and the remainder of Lot K shown on Plan RH 188.30D. Copies of Plan RH 188.30D are filed with the Municipality of East London and on File 11/K/E-L/1 of the National Monuments Council. Held under Crown Grant ELF 14/59 (remainder of Lot K) and Crown Grant ELF 20/10 (Lot K1).

Historical interest

The original part of Queen's Park was donated to the inhabitants of East London in about 1880 by Mr Gately for use as a public park. This park is of particular botanical interest.

DECLARATION OF A NATIONAL MONUMENT

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Pieter Gerhardus Jacobus Koornhof, Minister of National Education, hereby declare a portion of Erf 3981 and Erf 3982, Stellenbosch, with the historic building of the Bloemhof Girls' Primary School thereon, to be a national monument.

Description

That portion of Erf 3981 and Erf 3982, shown and described on a diagram drawn up by Land Surveyor K. Friedlaender, dated 26 October 1975 and filed on File 3/K/S-B/14 of the National Monuments Council, with the inclusion of the historic building of the Bloemhof Girls' Primary School thereon, situate in the Municipality and Division of Stellenbosch and measuring as such approximately three thousand two hundred and fifty (3 250) square metres.

Architectural interest

The building of the Bloemhof Girls' Primary School, which was opened on 2 June 1907, is an outstanding example of the "eclectic" style of building of the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries. Together with other historic buildings in Van Ryneveld Street it forms a unique historical and architectural group.

Kragtens die bevoegdheid my verleen by artikel 10 (1) van die Wet op Nasionale Gedenkwaardighede, 1969 (Wet 28 van 1969), verklaar ek, Pieter Gerhardus Jacobus Koornhof, Minister van Nasionale Opvoeding, hierby Queen's Park, Oos-Londen, tot nasionale gedenkwaardigheid.

Beskrywing

Die park, bekend as Queen's Park, Oos-Londen, geleë op daardie gedeelte van Perseel K1 en die restant van Perseel K soos getoon op Plan RH 188.30D. Kopieë van Plan RH 188.30D is geliasseer by die Munisipaliteit van Oos-Londen en op Lêer 11/K/E-L/1 van die Raad vir Nasionale Gedenkwaardighede. Gehou deur Grondbrief ELF 14/59 (restant van Perseel K) en Grondbrief ELF 20/10 (Perseel K1).

Historiese belang

Die oorspronklike gedeelte van Queen's Park is teen 1880 deur mnr. Gately aan die inwoners van Oos-Londen as openbare park geskenk. Dié park is van besondere botaniese belang.

VERKLARING VAN 'N NASIONALE GEDENKWAARDIGHEID

Kragtens die bevoegdheid my verleen by artikel 10 (1) van die Wet op Nasionale Gedenkwaardighede, 1969 (Wet 28 van 1969), verklaar ek, Pieter Gerhardus Jacobus Koornhof, Minister van Nasionale Opvoeding, hierby 'n gedeelte van Erf 3981 en Erf 3982, Stellenbosch, met die historiese gebou van die Laer Meisieskool Bloemhof daarop, tot nasionale gedenkwaardigheid.

Beskrywing

Daardie gedeelte van Erf 3981 en Erf 3982, soos getoon en beskryf op 'n diagram opgestel deur Landmeter K. Friedlaender, gedateer 26 Oktober 1975 en geliasseer op Lêer 3/K/S-B/14 van die Raad vir Nasionale Gedenkwaardighede, met inbegrip van die historiese gebou van die Laer Meisieskool Bloemhof daarop, geleë in die Munisipaliteit en Afdeling Stellenbosch en groot as sodanig ongeveer drie duisend twee honderd en vyftig (3 250) vierkante meter.

Argitektoniese belang

Die gebou van die Laer Meisieskool Bloemhof, wat op 2 Junie 1907 in gebruik geneem is, is 'n uitstekende voorbeeld van die "eklektiese" boustyl van die laat negentiende en vroeë twintigste eeu. Tesame met ander historiese geboue in Vanryneveldstraat vorm dit 'n unieke historiese en argitektoniese kompleks.
