DESCRIPTION.

The Grand Parade, Cape -Town. The area known as the Grand Parade, bounded by Lower Plein, Castle Buitenkant and Darling Streets, according to the alignment of those streets at the date of this notice, in the City of Cape Town, Province of the Cape of Good Hope.

HISTORICAL INTEREST.

The Grand Parade is one of Cape Town's historical squares and was the military parade ground during the eighteenth and nineteenth centuries.
