

DECLARATION OF A NATIONAL MONUMENT

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Johannes Petrus van der Spuy, Minister of National Education, hereby declare Queen's Park, East London, to be a national monument.

Description

The park, known as Queen's Park, East London, situate on Lot KI and the remainder of Lot K as shown on Plan RH188.30c, filed with the Municipality of East London and on File 11/K/E-L/1 of the National Monuments Council, measuring 35,972.1 hectares.

Held in terms of Title Deed ELF14/59 (remainder of Lot K) and Title Deed ELF20/10 (Lot KI).

Historical Interest

The original part of Queen's Park was donated to the inhabitants of East London in about 1880 by Mr Gately for use as a public park. This park is of particular botanical interest.
