

DECLARATION OF A NATIONAL MONUMENT

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Johannes Petrus van der Spuy, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the historic cemetery at Kleinbosch, Dal Josafat, to be a national monument.

Description

The cemetery at Kleinbosch, Dal Josafat, situate on certain piece of freehold land in the Division of Paarl, known as Section 1, being a portion of a certain piece of land transferred to E. S. du Toit on 6 July 1859 under Deed of Transfer 141 and to the Appearer's Principal on 19 July 1880 under Deed of Transfer 649, measuring as such 74 square roods 86 square feet. Deed of Transfer 3792/1939, dated 19 April 1939.

Historical interest

This cemetery was laid out in about 1700 by the Huguenot ancestor, Francois du Toit, on his farm Kleinbosch. Three of the founders of the "Genootskap van Regte Afrikaners", namely the Rev. S. J. du Toit, D. F. du Toit and P. J. Malherbe, are also buried here.
