DECLARATION OF A NATIONAL MONUMENT

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Johannes Petrus van der Spuy, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the Dutch Reformed (N.G.) Church building known as the "Groot Kerk", Graaff-Reinet, including the erf on which it stands, to be a national monument.

Description

The Dutch Reformed Church known as the "Groot Kerk", with the inclusion of the erf on which it stands, being Erf 1495 Graaff-Reinet (previously known as a certain piece of land adjoining Church Square on the north; Erf 4 on the west and Erf 3 on the north) and measuring as such 400 square roods, 137 square feet and 72 square inches. Deed of Transfer 5/3 (Graaff-Reinet Freeholds), dated 12 September 1833.
