## DECLARATION OF A NATIONAL MONUMEN

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 196 I, Johannes Petrus van der Spuy, Minister of Nation Education, hereby declare the historic village knowns Matjiesfontein, with the Victorian buildings therein, 100 a national monument.

## Description

The property known as Matjiesfontein Village, with th historic buildings therein, consisting of the followin? properties:

1. Certain piece of redeemed quitrent land, being Eif Matjiesfontein, in the Division of Laingsburg, anio measuring four thousand and forty-four (4044) squat metres.
2. Certain piece of redeemed quitrent land, being Erf 2 Matjiesfontein, in the Division of Laingsburg, and measuring four thousand and forty-four (4044) squari metres.
3. Certain piece of redeemed quitrent land, being Erf 3 . Matjiesfontein, in the Division of Laingsburg, and measuring four thousand and forty-four (4044) square metres.
4. Certain piece of redeemed quitrent land, being Erf 4 Matjiesfontein, in the Division of Laingsburg, and measuring four thousand and forty-four (4044) square metres.
5. Certain piece of redeemed quitrent land, being Erf 5 Matjiesfontein, in the Division of Laingsburg, and measuring four thousand and forty-four (4044) square metres.
6. Certain piece of redeemed quitrent land, being Erf 6. Matjiesfontein, in the Division of Laingsburg, and measuring four thousand and forty-four (4044) square metres.
