DECLARATION OF A NATIONAL MONUMENT

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969 I, Johannes Petrus van der Spuy, Minister of Nation Education, hereby declare the historic village known Matjiesfontein, with the Victorian buildings therein, 16 a national monument.

Description

The property known as Matjiesfontein Village, with the historic buildings therein, consisting of the following properties:
